LANGUAGE A1 SELF-TAUGHT

Students need to be native fluent readers and writers of the language

LANGUAGE B

A foreign language program where students have been studying the subject as a second language for three years

LANGUAGE A2

More challenging than Language B, and includes the study of more literature.

HISTORY A two-year program - Year one: U.S. History (to AP level)
Year two : World History with a European Focus

BUSINESS & MANAGEMENT

A two-year higher level course in which students learn about microeconomics, financial planning, marketing, finance and management

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

A two-year course leading to the HL IB examination. Includes materials science, CAD, the Design Cycle, design & construction of artifacts. This course is recommended for students who are already taking another IB science, or who may wish to combine this with IB Visual Arts with a view to applying to an art school.

MATHEMATICAL STUDIES

Pre-calculus, trigonometry. Accelerated students take AP calculus in the senior year

MATHEMATICS SL

An introduction to calculus. Suitable for students who will require calculus for college studies

MATHEMATICS HL

Calculus and beyond; students may also take the AP Calculus AB or BC examination. A two-year course. Designed for students who may be studying mathematics in college
